THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFORE INVESTING IN AUSTRALIA

Unlike many other countries around the world, the Australian government does not impose restrictive foreign investment laws or banking regulations on foreign investors. This makes the process of investing in Australia relatively easy, provided you have the right guidance.

Listed below are a few things that you should be aware of when investing in Australia.



While offshore investments are welcome by the Australian government, certain policies are in place to regulate the stability of the Australian property market. Australia's foreign investment policy dictates that foreign investment should be channeled to the housing sector to increase the supply of new residential properties.

If you are an overseas investor, you will be required to get permission from the Foreign Investment Review Board (F.I.R.B) to buy property in Australia. The application process is relatively straightforward and typically approved within 30 days. Buyers must submit their application to the F.I.R.B before purchasing a property, however this will normally be taken care of by your solicitor.

FOREIGN INVESTOR DUTY

Foreign investors who wish to invest in residential property in Australia will be required to pay an additional 7% of the purchase price in stamp duty. For home and land purchases, this amount will be calculated based on the value of the land component only (not the build cost).

TAX IMPLICATIONS

Similar to other countries, if your investment property generates an income then you will be taxed on that income. However, Australia's competitive depreciation rates make Australian properties fairly tax effective and there are many methods of reducing or deferring tax in Australia. When it comes to minimising the tax payable, you can rely on our network of professionals such as lawyers and accountants to help you optimise your cash flow.



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

To purchase a property in Australia, you must be represented by a solicitor who is registered in the state in which you are buying your property.
